2019 SPRING RIESLING

On the western face of the Strathbogie Ranges, this vineyard sees long cool mornings and warm afternoon sun, producing fruit with a distinctly different profile from our original Riesling vineyard. Now in our fifth year of working with this site, we're beginning to see an elegance and definition to the fruit that can only be attributed to vine maturity.

TASTING NOTE

We have chosen not to provide traditional tasting notes for any of our wines. Our wines hopefully capture vineyard life and vitality. As such the wines are constantly evolving. The only tasting notes that matter are yours.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

A hot and exceptionally dry growing season, yields were low in 2019, but delivered grapes with intense flavours and restrained aromatics, supported by the pure phenolics only Riesling can produce.

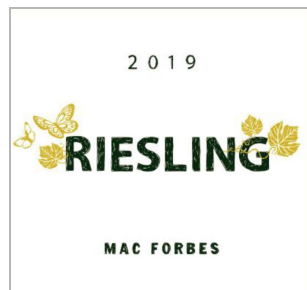
