2020 SPRING RIESLING

On the western face of the Strathbogie Ranges, this vineyard sees long cool mornings and warm afternoon sun, producing fruit with a distinctly different profile from our original Riesling vineyard. Each season, we continue to learn more about the nuance and personality of this maturing site.

TASTING NOTE

We have chosen not to provide traditional tasting notes for any of our wines. Our wines hopefully capture vineyard life and vitality. As such the wines are constantly evolving. The only tasting notes that matter are yours.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

A surprising season in the Strathbogie Ranges, 2020 was marked by consistent warm weather with few of the temperature spikes experienced in other Victorian growing regions. This protection allowed for slow, steady flavour development with high acid retention, which was tempered by a significant rain event on the western face of the Ranges just prior to harvest.
